Ways in to Worship

An introductory course designed as a stepping stone for those wishing to explore their calling or gain some worship leading skills without committing to the full, 2 year fully-accredited course. That might be for those feeling a special calling to the role of Worship Leader within their local congregation, but it will be equally useful for those who find that they are called upon to organise Local Arrangement services or worship in other contexts.

We keep things informal and practical —we'll practice writing and sourcing worship material and share experiences and, together, we'll discover more about:

- **What is corporate worship?** What makes it different from worshipping on our own?
- **The Structure of worship** - the elements that need to be in place and how to arrange them so that the worship has a natural flow and shape
- **Presentation skills** - help with voice projection and how best to present yourself as you lead others in worship
- **Ways of preparing beforehand**
- **Leading Prayer in worship**
- **Choosing and using music in worship**
